Diocesan Convention

The 223rd Annual Diocesan Convention will be held at All Saints Hilton Head on February 21-22. Our delegates are LaClaire Laffitte and Mary Bryan and our alternate delegate is Jamie Norris. The theme of the convention is “We All Are Ministers”. A highlight of the convention will be welcoming FIVE new missions into the diocese

An important part of the convention is the pre-convention workshop led by Rick Govan where the participants will explore their call to “live out their ‘baptismal ministry’” and how to develop good practices to build and maintain a vibrant parish. The workshop is Friday, February 21 and is open to everyone! The morning session is from 10 -12 am and the afternoon session is from 1- 3 pm. Please let us know if you would be able to attend. Absalom Jones Feast Day

Each year Voorhees College celebrates Absalom Jones Feast Day on the second Tuesday in February. This year the service is at 11 am on February 11th at their chapel on Voorhees College campus in Denmark, SC. Voorhees College is a fully accredited historically black liberal arts college located in Denmark, SC that is affiliated with the Episcopal Church. Voorhees has several programs that serve Hampton county students. Its founder Elizabeth Evelyn Wright-Menafee at one time tried to start the school in Hampton county. Absalom Jones was a slave who became one of the founders of the black Episcopal church in America. Each year the college celebrates Absalom Jones Feast Day with a service with music provided by its choir. The Bishops from both dioceses participate. They are initiating a scholarship fund to fund a scholarship for a deserving student that they will give in Absalom Jones’ name. The vestry voted that our loose plate offering for the last two Sundays in January and first two Sundays in February will be given to this scholarship. If you would like to mail in an additional donation it would be greatly appreciated.

Shrove Tuesday

Lent is coming soon, so that means that Shrove Tuesday is fast approaching - March 4th. This is a good opportunity to invite your friends to join us for a good meal, good fellowship, and fun. The Dobson’s have again offered to fix the pancakes for our Shrove Tuesday dinner. Of course you will be cleaning out all of your sweets, etc. in anticipation of Lent, so volunteer to bring some syrup, honey, butter, etc. for the feast. Other items needed are meats – cooked sausage, bacon, ham, etc, juice, milk, and paper items. There is a signup sheet in the parish house and in the back of the church.

Start bringing in your crosses from last Palm Sunday. You can put them in the offering plate or leave them in the offering plate at the back of the church. We will have the burning of the crosses (making the ashes for Ash Wednesday) at 6 pm with dinner starting immediately afterwards.

And the next day is Ash Wednesday. Father Dan Eckman will supply for us for Ash Wednesday. The service will start at 6 pm so that he can get back to Mr. Pleasant before too late.

Lenten Study

Father Dan Eckman suggested during a homily last year that we use a study program called 24 Hours That Changed the World by Adam Hamilton for a Lenten study. The series will help us relive the one day in history that changed everything. We will use the DVD to visit the sites where everything took place. We will walk the road that Jesus walked on that last day. We will have the program on the Wednesdays during Lent. We are planning to have a light supper. Stay tuned for more details later.
